## THE COLIC CONSULTATION

- Parent/carer comes into pharmacy distressed about their infant's symptoms
- Confirm if symptoms are suggestive of colic
- Rule out other conditions or red flag symptoms – ensure there is no evidence of infant failure to thrive, fever or illness
- Advise and offer parents/carers reassurance and give practical advice for soothing symptoms
- Dietary changes may be considered to reduce colic symptoms (to be discussed with GP)
- Provide advice on when parents/carers should see their GP or health visitor

The precise cause of colic is not fully understood, 10 but some of the implicated digestive factors include:
